

ORDINANCE NO. 2012-11

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CLINTON COUNTY, INDIANA, ADOPTING THE AMERICANS WITH DISABILITY ACT (ADA), DESIGNATING THE ADA COORDINATOR, AND ADOPTING PROCEDURES

WHEREAS, the Federal government enacted the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (ADA) to prevent discrimination of the physically and mentally disabled relating to employment and access to public facilities; and

WHEREAS, in compliance with Title II of the ADA Clinton County shall name an ADA Coordinator; and

WHEREAS, in compliance with Title II of the ADA Clinton County shall adopt a grievance procedure for resolving complaints alleging violation of the Title II of the ADA; and

WHEREAS, in compliance with Title II of the ADA Clinton County shall post the ADA Coordinator's name, office address, and telephone number along with the ADA Notice and ADA Grievance Procedure on its website; and

WHEREAS, in compliance with Title II of the ADA Clinton County shall adopt the 2005 Guidelines for Accessible Public Rights of Way, and the 2010 Americans with Disabilities Act Standards for Accessible Design, including but not limited to any enforceable standards or updates required by future changes to Title II of the ADA.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CLINTON COUNTY as follows:

SECTION I Theresa Martin is designated as the ADA Coordinator for Clinton County, Indiana.

SECTION II The Notice under the Americans with Disabilities Act, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A", is adopted as Clinton County's Notice under the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA).

SECTION III The Clinton County Grievance Procedure under the ADA, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "B", is adopted as the grievance procedure for addressing complaints alleging discrimination on the basis of disability in the provisions of services, activities, programs or benefits by Clinton County.

SECTION IV In compliance with Federal and State Laws as set forth above, the Board of Commissioners of Clinton County resolves to post the required information regarding the ADA Coordinator, Notice under the ADA, and the Clinton County Grievance Procedure under the ADA on its website and at such other locations as may be determined from time to time.

SECTION V This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption by the Board of Commissioners.

Passed and adopted by the Board of Commissioners of the County of Clinton, with unanimous consent on the date of its introduction, this 5th day of November, 2012.
